DIRECTIONS:

Using NJ Turnpike—Take **Exit #4**. Bear right onto 73N. Go approx 1.5 mi and turn rt onto 295 S. Take **Exit #34B** from 295 onto 70 W. Proceed 1 mi and take right-hand jug handle for Haddonfield & Maple Shade, Rt. 41, & 154. Follow jug handle to light and turn left onto Kings Hwy, which will take you to traffic light for Rt. 70. Cross Rt. 70 onto Rt. 154, Brace Rd., and follow for 1.2 miles to the 2nd traffic light and turn right onto Bortons Mill Rd. The entrance to the Challenge Grove Park is straight ahead. Proceed several hundred yards to the Pavilion which will be on the right. Parking is available on either side of the drive.

From the North, traveling South on 295: Exit at #34B and follow directions above.

From the South, traveling North on 295: Follow 295N to Exit #32 (Haddonfield/Gibbsboro Rt. 541). At the top of exit ramp, turn left. Follow for approximately 0.8 miles to the 4th traffic light and turn rt onto Rt. 154 North, Brace Rd. Turn left onto Bortons Mill Rd. and park straight ahead on right.
