LEARN WHAT GOES ON IN THE SHOW RING!

Directions: Challenge Grove Park

Using the NJ Turnpike (from either North or South): Travel the Turnpike to Exit #4. Bear right onto Rt. 73 North. Travel approx one-half mile and make a right onto Rt. 295 South. Take Exit #34B off of Rt. 295 onto Rt. 70 West. Travel 1 mile and make a right hand jug handle marked for Haddonfield and Maple Shade, Rt. 41 & 154. Follow jug handle to light and make a left onto Kings Highway, which will bring you to the traffic light at Rt. 70. Cross over Rt. 70 onto Rt. 154, Brace Road, and follow for 1.2 miles to the 2nd traffic light and make a right onto Bortons Mill Road. The entrance to Challenge Grove Park is straight in front of you. Proceed several hundred yards to the Pavilion, which will be on the right. Parking is available on either side of the drive.

From the North, Traveling South on 295: Follow directions from above after taking Exit #34B.

From the South, Traveling North on 295: Follow Rt. 295 North to Exit #32 for Haddonfield/Gibbsboro Rt. 541. At the top of the Exit ramp make a left. Follow for approx. 0.8 miles to the 4th traffic light and make a right onto Rt. 154 North, Brace Road. Make a left onto Bortons Mill Road and park straight ahead on right.
